and

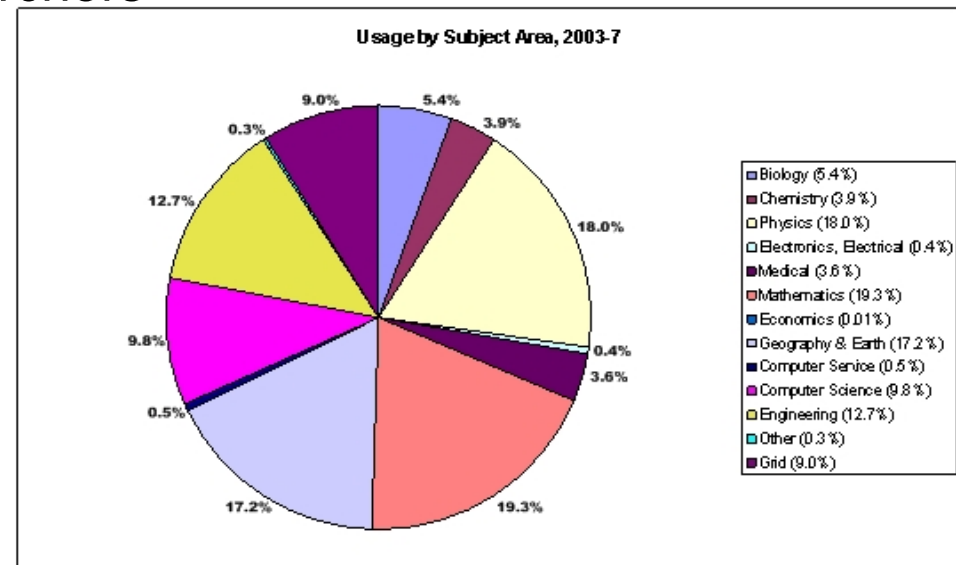
(3) to give you an opportunity to influence the ongoing and future work of the DCC

About WRG



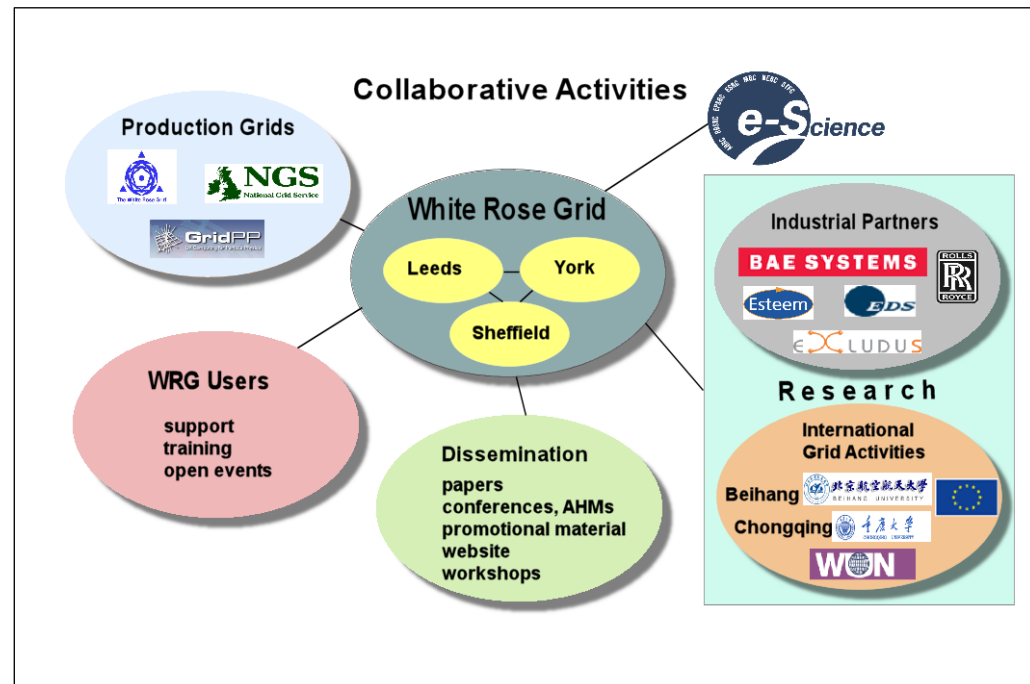
- Successful and long-standing partnership of the three Universities' research communities and service providers (CICS, ISS, Comp. Science)
